## **Arkansas Licensing Process**

- Obtain license application by visiting <u>http://www.state.ar.us/insurance</u>.
- 2. Complete the Arkansas State Police Form ASP-122 and \$22 cashier's check payable to the "Arkansas Insurance Department" (no personal checks accepted)
- 3. Apply on-line for your license with the National Insurance Producer Registry at <a href="https://www.nipr.com">www.nipr.com</a>.
  - a) Apply for the Resident Producer license.
  - b) License fee is \$70 plus \$5 for the on-line application fee.
- 4. Go to www.statebasedsystems.com to print your license.

NOTE: If you answer yes to any question on the Arkansas license application you must attach a statement detailing what occurred and what was the outcome of the occurrence. The application indicates what additional documentation is required.



5. Submit a copy of your license with the \$12 processing fee and your associate number by mail, email, or fax, to:
